## **What is Chicagoland Natural Gas Savings Program?**

- Chicago's first-ever regional natural gas rebate program for residential customers of Peoples Gas and North Shore Gas Companies.
- Rebates are offered for energy efficient clothes washers, insulation, water heaters, furnaces, and boilers.
- Program rebates are available for qualifying purchases made between May 1 and October 31, 2009.

## **Which clothes washers are eligible for the rebates?**

ENERGY STAR-qualified clothes washers are eligible for program rebates. Product lists are available with sales associates or can be downloaded from the program website at [www.conservationrebates.com](http://www.conservationrebates.com).

## **How much is the rebate?**

Qualifying clothes washer rebates are \$100 per home, limited to one washer per home.

## **How do customers participate?**

1. Select a qualifying product from the program list
2. Purchase and install the qualifying product
3. Complete and submit the signed Chicagoland Home Efficiency Rebate Form, along with a copy of the sales receipt within 60 days of purchase.

Rebates checks are issued by mail.

*The Chicagoland Natural Gas Savings Program is funded by customers of Peoples Gas and North Shore Gas through a line item on the bill called the Enhanced Efficiency Program. The Program is guided by Peoples Gas, North Shore Gas, the Citizens Utility Board, the City of Chicago Department of Environment, the Environmental Law and Policy Center and the Illinois Attorney General's Office.*
